O R D E R
EXTENDING TIME

The above entitled matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on application of the Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company, which was allowed an inchoate water right by the decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County in the Deschutes River adjudication proceedings, for extension of time within which to complete the construction work and apply the water to beneficial use of said water rights.

It appears that the time fixed for the completion of such inchoate rights heretofore extended by the State Engineer expired January 1, 1947, and that said company has not fully completed its inchoate rights although it has made reasonable efforts to reclaim its lands, and has used due diligence in the prosecution of the work necessary therefore.

It further appears that the applicant has given notice by registered mail to the Jefferson County Water Conservancy District, Arnold Irrigation District, Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District, Crook County Municipal Improvement District, Central Oregon Irrigation District, Pacific Power and Light Co., North Canal Co., Bend Golf Course, Brooks-Scanlon Lumber Company, Oregon Trunk Railway, Powells Butte Irrigation District, Pringle Falls Electric Power and Water Company, Walker Basin Irrigation Co., City of Redmond, and that over 30 days have expired and no objections have been filed to the approval of said application.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time in which to complete the construction work and apply the water to beneficial use of said inchoate rights of the Central Oregon Irrigation District be and the same hereby is extended to June 30, 1947.
