## BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON GRANT COUNTY

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELLATION )
OF A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT )
IN THE NAME OF MINNIE GUERNSEY )

ORDER

On October 26, 1981, William Hueckman and Mary Hueckman submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Grant County, entered November 16, 1956, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of John Day River, tabulated in the name of Minnie Guernsey, at page 513, Volume 10, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 25254, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Minnie Guernsey, and is for the use of water from a series of springs forming a slough in  $SE^{1}_{4}$   $NE^{1}_{4}$ , Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1870, for irrigation of 0.6 acre and domestic use in  $SW_{4}$   $NE^{1}_{4}$ , Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 25254, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
