FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A request to renew a short-term lease agreement, which proposed to lease all or a portion of certificate(s) 36708 and 9693 for instream purposes, was submitted to the Department by:

2. The instream lease application included the required fees. The Department assigned this lease agreement number L-11.
3. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6). No comments were received.
4. The previous lease commenced on May 15, 2002, not the May 5, 2002, date indicated on the lease application.
5. Based upon review of the application, comments received, and information provided by the Department's Watermaster, the Department finds that the lease, as modified, will not result in injury or enlargement.
6. The lease will terminate on October 31, 2008.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


The Department concludes that the lease, as modified above, will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the Short-Term Lease as described in application L-11 as modified is APPROVED.
