ORDER

The Colton Water District is the holder of permit No. 30560 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second of water from Jackson Creek for group domestic use.

The District has advised the State Engineer that construction of the facilities has not been completed, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development.

The District has further advised that due to a delay in the certification of the assessed value, the funds have not been available.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant said extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits to begin and complete construction under permit No. 30560 be extended to October 1, 1968.
