O R D E R


On July 23, 1982, Michael R. and Rebecca S. Herman of Route 1, Box 242, Terrebonne, Oregon, submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain water rights and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water rights and request the same be canceled.

The water rights in question were established by Decree of Circuit Court for Crook County, entered May 1, 1911 and September 19, 1914, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek, tabulated in the name of Mable Howard under Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, at pages 127 and 476, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the rights described by the certificate recorded at page 302d, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, for the use of not to exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, for domestic and irrigation of 8.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, WM and by the certificate recorded at page 850d, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, for the use of not to exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek with a date of priority of 1904 for domestic and irrigation of 6.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water rights, being portions of the rights described by certificates recorded at pages 302d and 850d, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
