ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. W-145

On March 27, 1969, Dan R. Warnock, Jr. filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Powder River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Baker County, Oregon, entered March 18, 1918, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Powder River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of J. L. Masters for the use of the waters of Powder River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 5.0 acres in NWW, NWW, 30.0 acres in SWW, NWW, and 5.0 acres in SEW, NWW, Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1910. This right is evidenced by certificate recorded at page 4332, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Salley McCord Ditch from a point of diversion located 300 feet north and 200 feet east from the W% corner of Section 28 being within the SWM, NWW, of Section 28, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, contract purchaser of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands by means of the Old Settler's Slough from a point of diversion to be located 370 feet south and 200 feet east from the W% corner of Section 21 being within the NW% SW% of Section 21, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Baker, Oregon, on July 16, 1969, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in The Record-Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Baker County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 22, 29 and June 5, 1969. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. George M. Ward, Watermaster of District No. 8, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No sujections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed smint of diversion of water may be established without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Powder River, to-wit:

From a point located 300 feet north and 200 feet east from the WM corner of Section 28 being within the SWM NWM of Section 28, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 370 feet south and 200 feet east from the W% corner of Section 21 being within the NWA SW% of Section 21, Township 9 South, Range 40 East. W.M.

for the irrigation of 5.0 acres in NWW, 30.0 acres in SWW, NWW, and 5.0 acres in SEW, NWW, Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1910, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1970.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. L. Masters and recorded at page 4332, Volume 5,

State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu
thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the
lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof
satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized
change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be
issued to Dan R. Warnock, Jr. confirming said change in point of
diversion.
