ORDER

APPROVING APPLICATION

On April 8, 1955 W. F. and Frances Zimmerman of Box 221, Pendleton, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from McKay Creek pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Umatilla County, entered

September 9, 1916 in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights
of the Various Claimants to the Use of the Waters of Umatilla River and Its
Tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of A. M. Despain for
the irrigation of 28 acres in the NE4 NW4, 20 acres in the NW4 NW4, 20 acres
in the SW4 NW4, 7 acres in the SE4 NW4, 15 acres in the NE4 SW4 and 10 acres
in the NW4 SW2, Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M., from
McKay Creek, of which 47 acres have a date of priority of 1894 and 53 acres
have a date of priority of 1907. Subsequently, on June 20, 1924, the State
Engineer entered an order approving the application of F. W. Johnson for a
change in place of use of water wherein the water right appurtenant to 6 acres
in the NE4 NW2, said Section 21, was transferred to the SW4 NE4, said Section 21.

Certificate of Water Right issued to E. W. Barnum and recorded at page 13424, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water of McKay Creek under Permit No. 14294 for the irrigation of 14 acres in the SE4 NW4 and 12 acres in the NE4 SW4, Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April 13, 1940.

All of the lands above described in paragraphs 2 and 3 hereof are irrigated through either the E B C Brothers ditch or the Kemler-Despain-Umatilla ditch, the point of diversion of the E B C Brothers ditch being located 700 feet north and 1475 feet west from the east quarter corner of Section 28, and

being within the SW $_4^1$ NE $_4^1$, said Section 28, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M., and the point of diversion of the Kemler-Despain-Umatilla ditch being located 600 feet north and 2100 feet west from the southeast corner of Section 21, and being within the SW $_4^1$ SE $_4^1$, said Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M.

The applicants herein, owners of 1.86 acres of the lands above described, to-wit: 0.69 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.53 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1391, and 0.78 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.6 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21, with a date of priority of 1907 and 2.26 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21, with a date of priority of April 13, 1910, proposes to irrigate said lands by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said pumping plant to be located south 28 degrees 10 minutes west 1627 feet from the northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 5h0.520 was given in the Pendleton Record, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Umatilla County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks, being the issues of April 28 and May 5 and 12, 1955. The time for hearing as fixed in the notice, namely: June 22, 1955, was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. M. J. Belton, Watermaster of District No. 5, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from McKay Creek may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from McKay Creek may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from McKay Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 700 feet north and 1475 feet west from the east quarter corner of Section 28, and being within the SW4 NE4, said Section 28, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M., and

From a point located 600 feet north and 2100 feet west from the southeast corner of Section 21, and being within the SW_4^4 SE_4^1 , said Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. N.,

To a point to be located south 28 degrees 10 minutes west 1627 feet from the northeast corner of the northwest quarter, Section 21, and being within the SE2 NW2, said Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M.,

for the irrigation of 0.69 acre in the NE_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} and 0.53 acre in the SE_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} , Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1894, and 0.78 acre in the NE_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} and 0.6 acre in the SE_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} , said Section 21, with a date of priority of 1907, and 2.26 acres in the SE_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} , said Section 21, with a date of priority of April 13, 1940, be and the same hereby is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1956 or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old points of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the pumping plant and related works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled. That the plans of the weir or other suitable device be approved by the watermaster of Umatilla County, Oregon, before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.
