An affidavit was received from PATRICK A. AND COLLEEN M. WILLIAMS, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 37659, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.15 cubic foot per second from GRAVEL PIT NUMBER 1, a tributary of PINE CREEK (BAKER VALLEY). The dates of priority are APRIL 14, 1965. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 12.0 ACRES
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 37659 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
