IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF HARRY K. COFFEY FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN POINTS OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM POWDER RIVER.

ORDER

APPROVING APPLICATION

On May 9, 1950, Harry K. Coffey of Fortland, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in points of diversion of water, from Powder River, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

Certificate of Water Right, recorded at page 1633, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was issued to H. C. Hainey and John E. Astner confirming a right under Permit No. 296 for the use of the water of Powder River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 36.5 acres in the NW4 SW4 and 33.5 acres in the SW4 SW4, Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 40 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April 19, 1910. The foregoing described lands are irrigated through the Kester-Swinyer-Myers ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located North 83° 16' West 23.80 Chains from the southeast corner, Section 2, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M., and being within the SW4 SE4, said Section 2.

Certificate of Water Right, recorded at page 3430, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was issued to Oscar Nelson confirming a right under Permit No. 4248 for the use of the water of Powder River for the irrigation of 30 acres in Lot 4 (NW¹₄ NW¹₄), Section 6, Township 8 South,

Range 40 East, W. M., with a date of priority of October 6, 1919. The fore-going described lands are irrigated through the New Haney ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located South 55° 05' West 8.30 Chains from the corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M., and being within the NE& NE&, Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described to which said water rights are appurtenant, proposes to change his points of diversion to a point to be located 350 feet south and 500 feet west from the corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 and being within the NE₄ NE₄, said Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O.C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that in applications for a change in point of diversion of less than one-fourth mile and where there are no intervening diversions between the old point of diversion and the new proposed point of diversion, no notice is required to be published.

Mr. J. W. Maxwell, Watermaster, District Number 2, Baker, Oregon, has submitted a statement to the effect that this proposed change in points of diversion was actually made some 25 years ago, that it would not affect anyone and that it would correct the records.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in points of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in points of diversion of water from Powder River, to-wit:

From a point located North 83° 16' West 23.80 chains from the Southeast corner of Section 2 and being within the SW₄ SE₄, Section 2, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M., heretofore used for the irrigation of 36.5 acres in the NW₄ SW₄ and 33.5 acres in the SW₄ SW₄, Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 40 East, W. M., and

From a point located South 55° 05' West 8.30 chains from the corner common to Sections 1, 2,11 and 12 and being within the NEt NEt, said Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M., heretofore used for the irrigation of 30 acres in Lot 4 (NWt NWt), Section 6, Township 8 South, Range 40 East, W. M.,

To a point to be located 350 feet south and 500 feet west from the corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 and being within the NEt NEt, said Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W. M.

for the irrigation of 36.5 acres in the NW SW and 33.5 acres in the SW SW, Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 40 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April 19, 1910 and 30 acres in Lot 4 (NW NW), Section 6, Township 8 South, Range 40 East, W. M., with a date of priority of October 6, 1919, be and the same hereby is approved.
