ORDER

On March 23, 1977, Morrow Bros., acting through Andrew J. Morrow, partner, submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right evidenced by certificate issued to Grizzly Livestock & Land Company and recorded at Page 13621, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of water from Willow Creek, with a date of priority of May 14, 1906, for the irrigation of a certain 1.7 acres in $SE_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NE_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 20; 11.9 acres in $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ and 3.6 acres in $NW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 15 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 13621, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
