On June 11, 1980, Jerry Braunverger, Administrative Assistant, Support Services, South Lane School District 45J3, submitted an affidavit that the School District is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the District has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 40774, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of South Lane School District 45J3, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second of water from Coast Fork Willamette River, with a date of priority of September 18, 1967, for irrigation of a certain 6.8 acres in NW4 SW4, as projected within Small D.L.C. No. 57, Section 33, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 40774, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
