#### ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6762 submitted by

PEMBROKE FARMS
7017 QUARRY AVENUE NE
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 14666, was perfected under Permit 14020 with a date of priority of AUGUST 31, 1939. The right allows the use of ABIQUA CREEK, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 9.1 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 3 (NW¼ SE¼), SECTION 23, T 6 S, R 1 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 24231, was perfected under Permit 21354 with a date of priority of MAY 6, 1952. The right allows the use of ABIQUA CREEK, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 12.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 3 (NW½ SE½), SECTION 23, T 6 S, R 1 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.
