
Findings of Fact

1. On December 2, 2019, MARK DOVERSPIKE, filed an application for additional points of diversion under an adjudicated, un-certificated right (Silvies River Decree, Harney County, Decree Volume 9, Page 79). The Department assigned the application number T-13297.
2. On July 30, 2020, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve T-13297.
