On March 8, 1963, Omer and Mary Summers and James and Leslie Lance filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the use of the Waters of Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of the Arnold Irrigation District for the use of the water of Deschutes River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 38 acres in the NW2 NW2 and 24.3 acres in the SW2 NW2, Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., with dates of priority of February 1, 1905, and April 25, 1905, being tabulated in the name of A. T. Taber. These lands also have a supplemental right under Permit No. 23255 to the use of the water stored in Crane Prairie Reservoir, with a date of priority of February 28, 1913.

The applicants herein, owners of 8.3 acres of the lands above described, to-wit: 7.0 acres in the NW½ NW½ and 1.3 acres in the SW½ NW½, said Section 22, propose to transfer the water right therefrom without loss of priority to 4.0 acres in the SW½ NE½ and 4.3 acres in the SE½ NE½, Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., owned by Frank R. Gilchrist.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water only.

Ralph W. and Glennys J. Boese, mortgagors of the lands from which it is proposed to transfer water, have submitted written approval to the change in place of use of water.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Arnold Irrigation District and the President and Secretary of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water on March 5, 1963.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same is approved and that the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 7.0 acres in the NW\$ NW\$ and 1.3 acres in the SW\$ NW\$, Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., with dates of priority of February 1, 1905, April 25, 1905 and February 28, 1913, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 4.0 acres in the SW\$ NE\$ and 4.3 acres in the SE\$ NE\$, Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1964, or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Arnold Irrigation District to the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially at the time certificates are issued confirming other transfers within the District.
