ORDER

On January 19, 1967, Pearl W. Woodruff submitted an affidavit that she is the owner of the NET NWT and the SET NWT, Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 39 East, W.M., and the water right appartenant thereto; that she has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and requests the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.99 cubic foot per second of the waters from Woodruff Well No. 1 for the primary irrigation of 39.0 acres in the NET NWT and 19.0 acres in the SET NWT, Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 39 East, W.M., with a date of priority of October 7, 1953, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of W. H. and Pearl Woodruff and recorded at page 27229, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

That part of the above described water right for the use of not to exceed 2.14 cubic feet per second of the waters of Woodruff Well No. 1 for the supplemental irrigation of 35.2 acres in the NE1 NE1, 38.4 acres in the NE1 NE2, 37.6 acres in the SW1 NE1, 38.6 acres in the SE1 NE1, 11.2 acres in the NE1 NW2 and 11.5 acres in the SE1 NW1, Section 11, and for the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second of the waters of Woodruff Well No. 4, for the supplemental irrigation of 1.2 acres in the NW1 NE1, Section 1, Township 4 Seuth, Range 39 East, W.M., with a date of priority of October 7, 1953, as evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of W. H. and Pearl Woodruff and recorded at page 27229, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right to the use of not to exceed 0.99 cubic foot per second of the waters of Woodruff Well No. 1 for the primary irrigation of 39.0 acres in the $NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ and 40.0 acres in the $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 39 East, W.M., with a date of priority of October 7, 1953, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right issued in the name of W. H. and Pearl Woodruff and recorded at page 27229, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a certificate be issued to Pearl Woodruff covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the use of not to exceed 2.14 cubic feet per second of the waters of Woodruff Well No. 1 for the supplemental irrigation of 35.2 acres in the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 38.4 acres in the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 37.0 acres in the SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 38.6 acres in the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 11.2 acres in the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ and 11.5 acres in the SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 11, and for the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second of the waters of Woodruff Well No. 4 for the supplemental irrigation of 1.2 acres in the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 39 East, W.M., with a date of priority of October 7, 1953.
