IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF HUGH O. THAYER FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM MALHEUR RIVER.

ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION

On October 31, 1934, Hugh C. Thayer filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Malheur River for the irrigation of 179.0 acres in Sections 29 and 32, Township 17 South, Range 47 East, W.M., with date of priority of 1909, said right being confirmed by Decree of the Court for Malheur County dated May 13, 1925.

The applicant proposes to abandon the pumping plant now being used for the irrigation of his lands and construct a gravity canal in lieu thereof. The point of diversion for the present pumping plant is located approximately 150 feet south and 150 feet west from the southwest corner of the NE¹/₄NV¹/₄ of Section 32, Twp. 17 South, Range 47 East, W.M., and the proposed new diversion for the gravity canal will be located upstream at a point approximately 170 feet north and 160 feet west from the east quarter-corner of Section 2, Twp. 18 South, Range 46 East, W.M.

Notice of publication was published in the Ontario Argus, a newspaper having general circulation in Malheur County for three weeks in the issues of November 22, 29 and Docember 6, 1934.

No objections having been filed against such application, it appears that such change can be made without injury to existing rights,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such change in point of diversion of water from Malheur River be and the same is hereby approved.
