ORS 540.570 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to temporarily transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On May 1, 2008, East Fork Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to temporarily change the place of use under portions of Certificates 81340 and 80929. The Department assigned the application number T-10616.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 81340, issued in the name of East Fork Irrigation District (confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County, recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director,

8. In conjunction with application T-10616, East Fork Irrigation District submitted an affidavit that states a portion of the proposed place of use has an appurtenant exisiting irrigation right under Permit 43395 issued in the name of East Fork Irrigation District. The affidavit states the District will not perfect this portion of the right evidenced by Permit 43395 and the right will not be used during the term of this temporary transfer. Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-385-3500)

- 9. The district temporary transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 10. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 11. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 12. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in application T-10372 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.570.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed temporary change in place of use to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 81340 and 80929 is approved.
- 2. The temporary transfer is effective for the 2008 irrigation season.
- 3. The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Water Right Certificates 81340 and 80929 and any related decree.
- 4. The use of water on the lands from which the water right is transferred and at the new temporary place of use during the same irrigation season or calendar year is prohibited and may subject the district and landowner to civil penalties.

- 5. The use of water under Permit 43395 at the proposed places of use ("TO" lands) shall not be used during the 2008 irrigation season, and the benenficial use of water under the right evidenced by Permit 43395shall not be perfected on the proposed places of use described in Findings of Fact #5 and #8.
- 6. The use of water under this temporary transfer may be conditioned or revoked at any time to the extent necessary to avoid injury if the Department finds the transfer causes injury to any existing water right.
- 7. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 8. The use of the remainder of the water rights not affected by this transfer under Certificates 81340 and 80929 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 81340 and 80929.
- 9. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 10. The water user shall maintain the existing headgate and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 11. At the end of the 2008 irrigation season all use of water under this temporary transfer reverts automatically to the terms and conditions of the original water right permit, certificate, or adjudication as evidenced by a court decree.
