ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7008 submitted by

JUNE E. WOOD AND LARRY LEE FLANAGAN 2009 N. FIR LAGRANDE, OR 97850

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 67641. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1872.

The right allows the use of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION. This right is limited to 2.0 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW¼ SW¼, Section 31, T 2 S, R 38 E, WM; 969' N and 886' E from SW corner Section 31, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and THREE acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ 40.0 ACRES NW¼ SW¼ 40.0 ACRES SECTION 21 SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 31, T 2 S, R 38 E, WM; 1858.33' S and 80.84' E from W¹/₄ corner or Section 31.

The applicant further proposes to change the place of use to:

SW¼ SW¼ 40.0 ACRES SE¼SW¼ 40.0 ACRES SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted prior to diverting water at the new point of diversion. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. When required by the Department, the water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.
- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.
- 6. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 67641 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
