

IN THE MATTER OF AN AMENDMENT)
 TO PERMIT NO. 6379 IN THE NAME)
 OF A. Y. MEYERS)

O R D E R

Mr. A. Y. Meyers of Marshfield, Oregon, being the holder of Permit No. 6379 has applied to the State Engineer for an order amending said permit with respect to the points of diversion described therein and the place where water is to be used.


The permit as originally filed describes three points of diversion, "Point A" being North 43 degrees 57 minutes West, 1348.3 feet; "Point B" being North 41 degrees 14 minutes West, 1302.4 feet; and "Point C" being North 45 degrees 33 minutes West, 1166.1 feet from the South quarter corner of Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 13 West W.M., all of these points being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34. It is proposed to leave diversion "Point A" as it is described in the original permit; to change diversion "Point B" to North 63 degrees 10 minutes West, 1327 feet from the South quarter corner of said Section 34, and to eliminate entirely diversion "Point C".

The place of use described in the original permit is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34. It is now proposed to use water both from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section.

The applicant having filed proper maps showing the proposed change in points of diversion and places of use, and it appearing that the proposed amendments to said permit do not constitute a material change in the plan of development, or the quantity of water used, and it further appearing that no injury to other users of the water will result from such an amendment.

It is therefore ORDERED that the amendments, as above outlined be and the same are hereby approved.
