By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered and the supplement of supplements of the submitted to the submitted the submitted to the su September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights ng Beliang at All, mga ping ara ing populating panglalak dal to the Use of the Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Arnold Irrigation District for the use of the waters Kater Beardone's Uticity suit of procession wil of Deschutes River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 4.0 acres in the lends to rerupt but the last  $S_4^1$   $NE_4^1$   $NW_4^1$  of Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 12 East, W.M., being tabulated in the name of E. Spurgeon, with dates of priority of February 1, 1905, and April 25, 1905, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at Page 29053, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These laids also have a supplemental right under permit No. 23256 to the use of the water stored in Crane Prairie Reservoir with a date of priority of February 28, 1913. These lands are irrigated by means of the Arnold Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 1.0 acre in NE2 SE2 and 1.0 acre in SE2 SE2 of Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M., being further described as within the Et of Tract 4. G. R. Brown Tracts (Unrecorded) in the names of Mary Lou Powell and Nancy

Hudson; and a certain 2.0 acres in  $SE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$  of said Sectior 12, being further described as within the  $E_2^1$  of Tract 3, G. R. Brown Tracts (Unrecorded) in the names of Harriet Horne/Bob Dillion.

Armold Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held January 19, 1977.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right will be issued to the Central Oregon Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.
