## ORDER APPROVING TEMPORARY CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 7969 submitted by

LARSON SKYLINE FARM 4395 HEINZE BOULEVARD ONTARIO, OREGON 97914.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 75566, was perfected under Permit 31231 with a date of priority of JUNE 27, 1966. The right allows the use of the SNAKE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 454.7 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 9.29 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 1 (NE¼ NW¼), SECTION 21, T 17 S, R 47 E, WM; 350 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 21, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 74023, was perfected under Permit 33944 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 25 1968. The right allows the use of the SNAKE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 139.1 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.48 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 1 (NE¼ NW¼), SECTION 21, T 17 S, R 47 E, WM; 350 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 21, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acrefeet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

- 5. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificates 75566 and 74023 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 75566 and 74023.
