ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

Wild River Orchards. Inc. P.O. Box 996 Medford, OR 97501

Findings of Fact

1. On March 23, 2005, Wild River Orchards, Inc. filed a transfer application to change the point of diversion, place of use, and character of use under Certificates 32728, 32742, 32746, and 32748. The Department assigned the application number T-9900.

2. The portions of the rights to be transferred are described as follows:

- 3. Supplemental Finding #7 of the Rogue River Decree, page 140 provides that in cases where the irrigated area in one legal subdivision is greater than or less than the acreage described in the claim, the water right will be allowed the actual irrigated amount in each subdivision, as long as the total number of acres under the claim does not exceed the number allowed by the decree. Therefore, the location of the transferred portions of the rights under these certificates can be re-described as shown in Finding #4 below, based on current surveying techniques and understanding of how the Public Land Survey subdivisions overlie the lands being transferred.
- 4. Notwithstanding the descriptions of the place of use on Certificates 32728 and 32746, the authorized place of use is:

8. Application T-9900 proposes to change the character of use for each of the rights to municipal.

- 9. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice. However, the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife did request inclusion of a condition requiring installation of proper fish screens.
- 10. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 14. The City of Central Point is the receiving land owner and will be responsible for completing the changes.

Partial Cancellation of Certificates 32728, 32742, 32746 and 32748

15. The applicant has submitted affidavits authorizing cancellation of the domestic and stock uses on the transferred portions of the rights described in Finding #2, as well as the additional portions of the rights under Certificates 32728, 32742, 32746 and 32748 described below:

Conclusions of Law

The changes in point of diversion, place of use, and character of use in proposed in application T-9900 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

- 1. The changes in point of diversion, place of use, and character of use in proposed in application T-9900 are approved.
- 2. Water right certificates 32728, 32742, 32746, and 32748 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued for 32728 and 32748 describing the portions of the rights not involved in this transfer.
- 3. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 32728, 32742, 32746, and 32748 and any related decree.
- 4. The portions of certificates listed in Finding #15 will be cancelled upon approval of T-9900.
- 5. The City of Central Point is responsible for completing the allowed changes to the water rights.
- 6. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2011.
- 7. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2012.
- 8. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion, being the diversion rate in cubic feet per second authorized for each right, further limited to the annual total volume in acrefeet listed in Finding #2 and summarized in Finding #5.
- 9. The former place of use of the transferred water shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- 10. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 11. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction, and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife. The water user may participate in the Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost-sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

12.	When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming
	the rights transferred will be issued.
