On June 23, 1988, Earl H. Staller submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be cancelled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 50462, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ruth Betty Langdon Berheim. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.035 cubic foot per second of water from a well with a date of priority of March 18, 1968, for irrigation of 4 acres in SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 50462, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is cancelled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
