On November 24, 1981, Velda J. Brust, for Painted Valley Ranch, submitted an affidavit that Painted Valley Ranch is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that Painted Valley Ranch abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Crook County, entered November 19, 1913, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, tabulated at page 443, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 850, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation District, and is for the use of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of 1904, for irrigation of a certain 20.0 acres in N 1/2 NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, WM, as described by the order of the State Engineer dated January 3, 1942, approving Transfer E-7.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 850, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
