IN THE MATTER OF THE CANCELATION OF WATER RIGHTS IN THE NAME OF EIMER Y. GLICK

ORDER

Mr. Elmer Y. Glick has submitted sworn statements that he is the legal owner of certain water rights and the real property to which the water rights are appurtenant; that he was abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water rights and requests the same to be canceled.

The water rights in question are for the storage of 9.0 acre feet of water from Murray Creek in a reservoir located within the NW4 SW4 and the SW4 SW4, Section 7, Township 5 South, Range 1 East and the SE4 SE4, as projected within J. Killins DLC No. 72, Section 12, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M., and for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second of water from Murray Creek and the reservoir for irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 4.6 acres in the NW4 SW4 and 16.8 acres in the SW4 SW4, Section 7, Township 5 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with the priority date of May 11, 1954, and are evidenced by the certificates recorded at Volume 20, pages 27757 and 27758, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right".

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water rights, evidenced by the certificates recorded at Volume 20, pages 27757 and 27758, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, are canceled.
