ORDER

On April 3, 1981, Ron and Jane Hudspeth of P. O. Box H, Prineville, Oregon, submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Crook County, entered April 13, 1914, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Crooked River tabulated in the name of Oregon and Western Colonization Company, at page 420, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 686, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Oregon and Western Colonization Company, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second of water from McKay Creek through the Powell Ditch, with a date of priority of 1906, for irrigation of 35 acres in the NW4 NW4 and 5 acres in the SW4 NW4, Section 17, Township 14 South, Range 16 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 686, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
