IN THE MATTER OF CANCELLATION OF A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT IN THE NAME OF CLYDE WARD)))	ORDER

On June 27, 1937, Clyde Ward and Leonora Ward submitted an affidavit that they were the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they had abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requested the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 3415, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Clyde Ward, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second of water from Powder River, with a date of priority of February 26, 1917, for irrigation of a certain 10.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 9, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 3415, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
