On October 22, 1987, Raymond J. and Eileen Kuenzi submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 49286, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Denzel J. Brown. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.037 cubic foot per second of water from a well, with a date of priority of February 15, 1974, for irrigation of 2.3 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 1.7 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 1.4 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4, and 1.8 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 9, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 49286, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
