Dean O. Johnson submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a water right and the land to which it is appurtenant. He has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be cancelled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by certificate 975, State Record of Water Right Certificates in the name of H. M. Butler, with a priority date of 1901. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.296 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek through the McCallister Ditch for irrigation of 14.8 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 7, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by certificate 975, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is cancelled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
