## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On August 22, 2018 the Final Order Approving Transfer Application T-12921 was issued by the Department as evidenced by Special Order Volume 109, Page 135-139.
- 2. The order contained a scrivener's errors in was identified in Finding of Fact No.8 regarding the Water Use Measurement Conditions, required to be included in the order by the watermaster.
- 3. The correct conditions are as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing) or at each new point of appropriation.
- b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is/are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The order approving Temporary Transfer Application T-12921, recorded at Special Order Volume 109, Pages 135-139 is amended to correct the scrivener's errors in the water use measurement conditions.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of Special Order Volume 109, Page 135-139 remain the same.
