ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7527 submitted by

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 55602. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 11, 1894.

The right allows the use of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC SUPPLY FOR THE CITY OF STANFIELD, OREGON. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 11.58 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE¼ NW¼, SECTION 8, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; DILLON DIVERSION DAM - 2340 FEET SOUTH AND 2900 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 8, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 31, T 4 N, R 29 E, WM; 1720 FEET NORTH AND 2320 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 31.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

- 3 The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The water user may participate in the Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

5. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

Certificate 55602 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
