IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE HOLLYWOOD DEVELOPMENT COMPANY FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN THE CHARACTER OF USE OF WATER UNDER PERMIT NO. 2520.

ORDEF

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing:

Permit No. 2520 of the State Engineer was issued July 14, 1915, to John M. Raynolds covering the right to appropriate 1.35 second feet of water from a spring and Leavens Creek for domestic and power purposes. The quantity of water proposed to be used from the spring was one-half second foot, the balance to be taken from Leavens Creek. The Hollywood Development Company, the petitioner herein; has now succeeded to all of the rights and interests of said John M. Raynolds under said permit and the lands connected therewith, and now asks for the approval of a change in the use of the water from power to domestic purposes.

Notice of the filing of said application has been given by the State Engineer by publication in a newspaper printed and having general circulation in the county in which such water rights are located, as provided by Section 5764, O.L., as amended by Chapter 219, Laws of 1927, and no objections to such application have been filed.

A personal inspection of said appropriation has been made by a representative of the State Engineer, and it appears that under said permit, the water has been used from the spring only, and that no use of the water from Leavens Creek has been made. It further appears, that the appropriation from the spring was duly perfected to the extent of one-half cubic foot per second for power purposes, but that the petitioner new desires to use said water for domestic use entirely, for supplying dwellings to be constructed when said lands are subdivided and sold off for home sites.

NOW, THEREFORE, it appearing that said change may be made without injury to the rights of any others parties, it is CRDERED that the change in the use of water under said water right from power use to domestic use be and the same is hereby approved.
