O R D E R


On November 25, 1968, Dave H. Jordan submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in a certificate of registration; that he has abandoned said claim of water right and requests the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 129 gallons per minute from a well located S. 77° 30' W. 790 feet from the southeast corner of Smiley Carter D.L.C. in Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a beginning date of 1942, for irrigation of 6.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 15.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and is described in certificate of registration recorded in Volume 3, page 415, Ground Water Registration Records.

That part of the claimed right for the use of not to exceed 111 gallons per minute from the described well for irrigation of 6.7 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15 and 11.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and described in said certificate, is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 129 gallons per minute from a well located S. 77° 30' W. 790 feet from the southeast corner of Smiley Carter D.L.C., Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a beginning date of 1942, for irrigation of 6.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 15.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W.M., is canceled.
