ORDER

On August 20, 1955 and on January 5, 1966, Frank R. Prow submitted affidavits that he is the legal owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned all intercat in and to said right except for domestic use and requests the remainder to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second of the waters of Mineral Creek and a small unnumed spring, a tributary of Millamette Miver, for domestic use and the operation of a hydraulic ram in the SM SM, Section 1h, Township 8 South, Range h West, W.F., with a date of priority of December 16, 1927, evidenced by certificate of water right issued to John B. Pollock and recorded at page 9709, Volume 9, State Record of Water Might Certificates.

That part of the above described water right for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of the waters of Mineral Creek for demestic use of one family within the SW_1^2 SW_2^2 of Section 1h, Township 0 South, Hange h West, M.M., is not in question.

OND 5h0.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right to the use of not to exceed 0.2h cubic foot per second of the waters of Mineral Creek and of a small unnamed spring for the operation of a hydraulic ram and for domestic use from the small unnamed spring within the SUN SER of Section 1h, Township 8 South, Range & Wost, Walker, is canceled.

It is FULTHER OFDERED that certificate of water right recorded at page 9709, Volume 9, State Record of Mater Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a certificate be issued to Frank R. Prow covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of the waters of Mineral Creek for demestic use of one family in the SWA SEA, Section 14, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 16, 1927.
