
On March 31, 1971, Richard W. Kline, Virginia P. Kline, and Robert D. Kline submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right evidenced by certificate issued to W. G. Mayfield and recorded at page 3896, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.064 cubic foot per second of water from Rogue River, with a priority date of November 30, 1914, for the irrigation of 4.42 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15 and 0.7 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right evidenced by certificate recorded at page 3896, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
