ORDER

On August 9, 1982, Francis Frederick Allen of P.O. Box 791, Lakeview, Oregon, submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Lake County, entered May 15, 1923, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Thomas Creek, tributary of Goose Lake, tabulated in the name of William D. Bishop, at page 563, Volume 6, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 5227, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of William D. Bishop, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.385 cubic foot per second of water from Cox Creek, with a date of priority of 1890, for irrigation of 4.1 acres in the NE¼ NE¼ and 11.3 acres in the SE¼ NE¾ Section 29, Township 37 South, Range 20 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 5227, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
