## ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6385 submitted by

EDWARD A. NEWTON
9997 AZALEA GLEN ROAD
GLENDALE, OREGON 97442.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 996, was perfected under Enlargement Permit 25 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 18, 1909. The right allows the use of COW CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH FORK OF UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 33.0 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.41 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion:  $NW^{1}_{4}$   $SW^{1}_{4}$ , SECTION 35, T 32 S, R 6 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ 17.0 ACRES SE¼ SW¼ 16.0 ACRES SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW\( \) SW\( \), SECTION 34, T 32 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 2490 FEET SOUTH AND 1075 FEET EAST FROM W\( \) CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 996 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
