On January 8, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by George and Jerry Bulow for approval of a change in place of use of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 41879, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of George S. Bulow, describes a right which includes for the use of not to exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second from a well for irrigation of a certain 1.8 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, 4.8 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 5.6 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, W.M., with a date of priority of March 2, 1959.

The authorized point of appropriation is located 1390 feet North and 2390 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 4, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 26 East, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 7.6 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 1.6 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 3.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of said Section 4.

Mr. Steven P. Applegate, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 41879, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
