ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6896 submitted by

JENS REERSLEV C/O REERSLEV FARMS 220 EAST 18^{TH} AVENUE JUNCTION CITY, OREGON 97448.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 38114, was perfected under Permit G-3359 with a date of priority of JULY 1, 1966. The right allows the use of WELL NO. 4, in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW½ SE½, SECTION 29, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 590 FEET NORTH AND 2000 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 29, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SE% SW% 1.5 ACRES SECTION 29

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

SW¼ SE¼ 1.5 ACRES SECTION 29

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
- 2. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificate 38114 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
