**Findings of Fact**

On April 2, 2002, Cascade Meadow Ranch Association filed an application to transfer one of the points of appropriation under Certificate 80465 to a new well. The Department assigned the application number T-9074.

On May 17, 2004, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving T-9074. This order was recorded in the Special Order Volume 60, Page 77.


On April 8, 2005, David C. Grove, Cascade Meadow Ranch Board President, notified the Department that the change authorized through approval of transfer application T-9074 will not be completed and requested that the authorized point of appropriation revert back to the original point of appropriation.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010, the point of appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of appropriation if the change authorized by the transfer is not completed.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The point of appropriation for the right affected by application T-9074 is reverted to the last authorized point of appropriation prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued.
