On September 7, 1984, Richard Alexander, Administrator of Evangelical Lutheran Good Samaritan Society of 970 West Juniper Avenue, Hermiston, Oregon 97838, submitted an affidavit that Evangelical Lutheran Good Samaritan Society is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Umatilla County, entered September 9, 1916, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Umatilla River, tabulated in the name of United States of America, at page 242, Volume 3, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second of water from Umatilla River, with dates of priority of November 14, 1894, February 25, 1904 and September 6, 1905, for irrigation of 3.07 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 28 East, WM. (No certificate issued).

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right for the use of the waters of the Umatilla River for irrigation use, with dates of priority of November 14, 1894, February 25, 1904 and September 6, 1905, is canceled.
