IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO BEGIN AND COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMIT NOS. 33923 AND 44501 IN THE NAME OF CITY OF DUNES CITY

The City of Dunes City is the holder of Permit No. 33923 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 1.4 cubic feet of water per second from the Woahink Lake for domestic use and Permit No. 44501 which grants 1.5 cubic feet of water per second from Woahink Lake for municipal use.

The City has advised the Water Resources Director that the appropriation has not been made as described in the Permit, but it is the City's desire to preserve the right for this development.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant said extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits to begin and complete construction and make complete application of water under Permits Nos. 33923 and 44501 be extended to October 1, 1985.
