O R D E R
APPROVING APPLICATION

G-10

On February 9, 1944, Helen A. Goodrich and E. L. Goodrich filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries a right was recognized in the name of the squaw Creek Irrigation Company, now Squaw Creek Irrigation District, for the irrigation of, among other lands, 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April, 1899, and 4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 23 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November 1904. Subsequently, by an order of the State Engineer dated September 11, 1930, 20 acres of the water right appurtenant to the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., were transferred to other lands, leaving a balance of 3 acres appurtenant to said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

The applicants herein, owners of the water rights appurtenant to 50 acres of the above described lands, to-wit: 33 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of April, 1899, and 4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3

acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of November, 1904, propose to transfer the water right appurtenant thereto, without loss of priority, to 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April, 1899, and 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 31, with a date of priority of April, 1899, for 33 acres and November, 1904 for 7 acres.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606 O. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that notice is not required on applications for only a change in place of use of water.

All the lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District, the board of directors of said district having approved the proposed change in place of use of water at its regular meeting held December 7, 1943.


It appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 33 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April, 1899, and 4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November, 1904, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 33 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April, 1899, and 7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 31,

with a date of priority of November, 1904.

It is further ordered that complete application of water to beneficial use upon the land to which the water hereby is transferred shall be made on or before October 1, 1946, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
