An affidavit was received from PORTLAND GOLF CLUB, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be cancelled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by certificate 8186, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.09 cubic foot per second of water; being 0.02 cfs for irrigation and 0.07 cfs for domestic use, from FANNO CREEK, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1923.

The abandoned water right is for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE AND IRRIGATION OF 1.83 ACRES. A description of the place of use of the abandoned right and to which it is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.21 ACRE SECTION 13

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.42 ACRE SW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.20 ACRES SECTION 24 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate 8186 is cancelled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding upon receipt of satisfactory proof of appropriation under transfer 6338.
