On February 9, 1944, Helen A. Goodrich and E. L. Goodrich filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries a right was recognized in the name of the Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, now Squaw Creek Irrigation District, for the irrigation of, among other lands, 8 acres in the SW_4^{\perp} SE_4^{\perp} and 36.5 acres in the SE_4^{\perp} SE_4^{\perp} , Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, and 2 acres in the SW_4^{\perp} SE_4^{\perp} and 3.5 acres in the SE_4^{\perp} SE_4^{\perp} , said Section 31, with a date of priority of 1895.

The applicants herein, owners of the above described lands propose to transfer the water right appurtenant thereto without loss of priority to 4 acres in the SE_4^1 SW_4^1 , 3 acres in the SE_4^1 SE_4^1 , Section 30, and 33 acres in the NE_4^1 NE_4^1 , Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, and 10 acres in the NW_4^1 NE_4^1 , Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1895.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606 0. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that notice is not required on application for only a change in place of use of water.

All the lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District, the board of directors of said district having approved the proposed change in place of use of water at its regular meeting held December 7, 1943.

It appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 8 acres in the SW_{\pm}^1 SE_{\pm}^1 and 36.5 acres in the SE_{\pm}^1 SE_{\pm}^1 , Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, and 2 acres in the SW_{\pm}^1 SE_{\pm}^1 and 3.5 acres in the SE_{\pm}^1 SE_{\pm}^1 , said Section 31, with a date of priority of 1895, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 4 acres in the SE_{\pm}^1 SW_{\pm}^1 , 3 acres in the SE_{\pm}^1 SE_{\pm}^1 , Section 30, and 33 acres in the NE_{\pm}^1 NE_{\pm}^1 , Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of November 11, 1895, and 10 acres in the NW_{\pm}^1 NE_{\pm}^1 , Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of Priority of 1895.

It is further ordered that complete application of water to beneficial use upon the land to which the water hereby is transferred shall be made on or before October 1, 1946, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
