ORDER

On January 9, 1981, George R. Wright submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 34742, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Emory E. Moore, and is for the storage of not to exceed 20.4 acre-feet of water from an unnamed stream, with a date of priority of September 13, 1961, for storage of irrigation water in Emory Moore Reservoir, located in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 6 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 34742, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
