ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER 5521

On August 20, 1984, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert E. Proctor for approval of a change in place of use of water from Alder Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 20500, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Robert E. Proctor, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.002 cubic foot per second from Alder Creek, for irrigation of 0.2 acre in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM with a date of priority of May 2, 1949.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 450 feet North and 250 feet East from the Southwest Corner of SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 33, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the right therefrom to a certain other 0.2 acre in said SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM. The change in place of use is reported to be completed.

Gary L. Ball, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 20500, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
