FROM FIFTEEN MILE CREEK.)

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Water Board, on the petition of the City of Dufur, Wasco County, Oregon, by P. W. Knowles, Mayor and ex officio chairman of the Water Commission, and it appearing that said City obtains its water supply by a gravity system from Fifteen Mile Creek; the point of diversion being located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, T 2 S. R. 12 E. W. M., and that for the purpose of securing a more sanitary supply of water, application is made for permission to change the point of diversion about three miles upstream, to a point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, T 2 S. R. 12 E. W. M.; and it further appearing to the Board that the proposed change would apparently be of great advantage to the petitioner, but that there are several water users between the present diversion point of the City and the proposed new diversion point and that said parties have not been allowed an opportunity to be heard as to whether said change would work an injury to their rights, it is hereby ORDERED that said change is hereby approved, without prejudice to the rights of any other parties not having been heard herein.
