IN THE MATTER OF AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO BEGIN AND COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMIT NO. 7257 IN THE NAME OF THE CITY OF ASTORIA

ORDER EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The City of Astoria is the holder of permit No. 7257 which grants a right to the use of not to exceed 23.0 cubic feet per second of water from Young's River for municipal purposes.

The time for beginning of construction under the permit in question, as extended by the State Engineer, expired April 9, 1963. The time limits for completion of construction and complete application of water, as extended by the State Engineer, expired October 1, 1963.

The City of Astoria has advised the State Engineer that it has prepared plans and specifications for dams, transmission main and storage reservoir, and purchased land at dam and reservoir site costing \$36,000. The City is continuing its investigation in connection with this project and desires to preserve the right for this development.

It is considered by the State Engineer that the preservation of the right in question is consistent with the primit interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits for beginning and completion of construction and complete application of water under permit No. 7257 be and the same are extended to October 1, 1969.
