ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4613

On October 7, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Max E. Morrow for approval of a change in place of use of water from McCall Spring, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 8470, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Linder Brothers, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second from McCall Spring for domestic use in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 20, 1929.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 90 feet North and 296 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Isaac Lemasters DLC, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to use said water for domestic purposes in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of said Section 2, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Michael F. Ladd, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 8470, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
